#### Key Knowledge

Easter fits into the 'Big Story' as it recognises the concepts of the Gospel, Incarnation, Creation and the Fall.

Three important days in Holy Week are: Jesus entering Jerusalem (Palm Sunday), the day Jesus died (Good Friday), and the day Jesus came back to life (Easter Sunday).

Three significant crosses are: a palm cross, a crucifix and a plain cross.

Christians mark Good Friday and Easter Sunday through events and rituals.

Churches celebrate Holy Week in different ways.

Christian feelings and thoughts change during the Easter period.

For Christians, Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday are times to remember the joy, sadness, despair, and hope felt by the followers of Jesus, and by Jesus himself.
