

## Key Knowledge

Christians believe Jesus challenges everyone about how to live – he sets the example for loving God and your neighbour, putting others first.

Christians believe Jesus shows love and forgiveness to unlikely people.

Christians try to be like Jesus – they want to know him better and better.

Christians try to put his teaching and example into practice in lots of ways, from church worship to social justice.

Jesus' example and teaching emphasise loving one's neighbour – particularly the weak and vulnerable – as part of loving God.

Matthew, Mark, Luke and John wrote the four gospels, which are the events of Jesus' life, death and resurrection.

Matthew and John were eyewitnesses of much of Jesus' life and death because they were two of his 12 disciples.
