Key Knowledge

- The big story of the Bible is the Creation, Fall, and Redemption.
- The Bible contains many different text types e.g. letters, poetry/songs, wisdom (wise sayings about how to live), laws, prophecy (what will happen in the future).
- The Genesis creation account can be interpreted as a historical account or as poetry (figurative language).
- Christian scientists have a range of views on creation and evolution.
- Believers respond to God's creation in many different ways. e.g. poetry and music.
