Our school uniform consists of:

- Royal blue sweatshirt
- Pale blue polo shirt
- Grey trousers, skirt, shorts or pinafore
- Blue/ white gingham or striped dress
- Indoor P.E. kit - Navy shorts, navy t-shirt and drawstring P.E. bag
- Outdoor P.E. kit - Navy tracksuit and trainers
- Book bag

The uniform may be purchased from any supermarket or clothes store and do not need to have the school logo on. However, you may wish for certain items to be branded and have your child's initials placed on the items so that if they are misplaced they can be returned. Alternatively, parents/carers can write their child's name in each item of clothing.
